

Team Tarlton Raises \$190,000 to Benefit Cancer Research in 2019

Non-profit celebrates its inaugural year of impact and giving back, with significant monies raised and over 1,300 volunteer hours contributed across 12 events

- Hosted blood drives on the Menlo Park Labs campus that generated nearly 60 units of blood, potentially saving dozens of lives through [Stanford Blood Center](#)
- Donated 325 backpacks for disadvantaged children to start off the school year with the proper supplies through non-profit partner [Family Giving Tree](#)
- Donated 310 gift cards to the families of children in the local community
- Hosted 300 cyclists at Team Tarlton Energizer Stations at Silicon Valley's annual [Bike to Work Day](#)
- Mobilized 175 individual financial donors and contributed more than 1,300 volunteer hours across 12 different events.

Team Tarlton originated out of CEO John Tarlton's commitment to supporting cancer research and carries on the company's long tradition of corporate social responsibility. Over the year, Team Tarlton has become a broader community movement, engaging many new donors and giving employees and tenants across Menlo Park Labs multiple opportunities to volunteer and give back. The organization plans to build on this momentum in 2020 with new programs and events.
